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Dear Parents,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the skills your three year old will be introduced to during this school year.

Your child's spiritual, physical, cognitive, and social-emotional development is interrelated. The curriculum guide (Wee Learn) is developed around themes which provide opportunities for the children to learn about God, Jesus, the Bible, the church, self, family, others and the natural world.

Some examples of these skills are listed below:

Spiritual Development: To know the difference between the Bible and other stories; to enjoy brief Bible stories and songs; will practice biblical concepts such as kindness and helpfulness and learn about God through relationships with others.

Cognitive Development: Teachers ask thought provoking questions during story times; introduction of colors and shapes; alphabet letters and number pre-writing skills with hands-on experience; problem solving activities such as puzzles, math games, balancing a block structure and simple scientific experiments.

Social-Emotional Development: Providing experiences to enhance positive self image; learning to play with others and try to verbally work things out; learning the importance of manners-saying "thank you" and "please" as well as role playing for learning about feelings of happy, sad and anger.

Physical Development: Many opportunities to enhance gross motor skills such as climbing, bike riding, sliding and running; experiences for fine motor skills such as using scissors, markers, crayons, playdough; stringing beads and a sensory table.
