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Dear Parents,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the skills your four year old will be mastering during this school year.

Your child's spiritual, physical, cognitive, and social-emotional development is interrelated. The curriculum guide (WEE LEARN) is developed around themes which provide opportunities for the children to learn about God, Jesus, the Bible, the church, self, family, others and the natural world.

Some examples of these skills are listed below:

Spiritual Development: Child understand the Bible is true and teaches us about God; God hears us when we pray; God created all things; can discern right from wrong and knows that God loves them; Jesus is God's son and He came as a baby and grew up just like children do today.

Cognitive Development: Child can recognize his/her name and may write it; can problem solve as they work with a variety of manipulatives; recognize shapes, colors, most numbers and letters; learn to recognize words by the phonemic awareness and phonics; will learn math skills by sorting, classifying, and sequencing objects.

Social -Emotional Development: Child will respect others work, play share, take turns, and get along with others; understand routines, limits and attempts to follow rules; learn to resolve conflicts in appropriate ways; joins in and participates in group activities.

Physical Development: Child displays gross motor skills as they hop jump, run, skip and climb; displays fine motor skills as they bounce, throw and catch a ball; has good eye and hand coordination by writing, cutting, and holding a pencil correctly; develop good health and hygiene habits.
